 - 5. WRITE 1 Q THAT YOU WOULD LIKE TO ASK ABOUT PRESENTING YOUR RESEARCH AT CONFIRMATION
- Explore postgraduate academic language and confirmation online resources.
- Learn how to present your research by creating clear concise complexity (CCCC).
